Police Chief Tom Ferretti to retire after 42 years of service

Search for next TPD leader currently underway

Trumansburg, NY- After more than five decades in law enforcement, Chief Thomas Ferretti is ready for a little rest and relaxation. Ferretti officially submitted his retirement notice on June 11th, which was shared by the Village Board at their monthly meeting later that evening. A search for the next Chief is currently underway, with the goal of making a hire by mid-July.

For the past 42 years, Ferretti has been at the helm of the Village of Trumansburg Police Department. In that time, not only has he worked tirelessly to serve and protect the Village, he has also been a member of the local business community.

Mayor Rordan Hart, who served as police commissioner during his time as a Village Trustee, applauded Ferretti's service to the Village. "Chief Ferretti's dedication to safety and community engagement has created a model for small town police departments," said Hart. "He has set a high bar for the next Chief and we'll miss him dearly."

Chief Ferretti has given two-thirds of his life to policing and his reasons for retirement boil down to simply, rest. "I have spent 51.5 years in law enforcement and I'm ready to relax, goof off, and travel," stated Ferretti. "It has been fun and at times, not so fun, but I've met many nice people over the years."
