- **All** take a look at the current zoning map. Do a personal walking (or driving) tour of neighborhoods. Make note of significant features, identify beneficial and challenging aspects of different neighborhoods. Think about what it would be like to live there.

- Review of zoning map and GIS maps.
- Outline a plan of the whole process of revising the comp plan.
- Plan the committee's walking tour of the community, which will tentatively take place later in April.
